The award consists of three substantially equal tranches. The amount awarded represents the maximum potential achievable number of shares. The number of shares in each tranche that ultimately vest is a function of the issuer's growth in tangible book value per common share plus accumulated dividends ("TBVPS + AD") during a given calendaryear performance period (2019, 2020 or 2021), and is subject to the reporting person's continued employment through the expiration of the service period. If, following the Compensation Committee's determination of growth in TBVPS + AD for a performance period, there are shares that are no longer eligible to vest, those shares will be immediately forfeited.
